33% Tuition Grant Credit for Undergraduate Programs & Graduate Programs in Human Services For AME Members from St. Joseph's College

This Grant has been developed for current AME Union Members in the United States who are pursuing a bachelor's degree at St. Joseph's College but who do not receive full tuition reimbursement from their employers. All of the baccalaureate degree programs at the Brooklyn and Suffolk campuses of St. Joseph's College are available to those who qualify for them. The award will provide a tuition credit equal to 33% of the prevailing St. Joseph's College Tuition. Applicants will be required to file for financial aid. The exact dollar amount of this Grant will vary according to the prevailing St. Joseph's College tuition each year, as well as the student's eligibility for other funds (PELL, TAP, APTS, Tuition Reimbursement, etc.). These other "outside" funds are subtracted from tuition before the St. Joseph's College Grant is applied to any remaining tuition charges. For those who meet the criteria, the Grant has been available since the academic year started in the Summer 2007 session.
